AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE AND MEDPAY

Many auto policies have an optional insurance plan called Med-Pay. Med-Pay stands for medical payments. It is insurance that covers your medical payments if you are involved in an automobile accident. Here are some of the benefits of Med-Pay:

- ❑ All occupants of the vehicle are covered for injuries
- ❑ Med-Pay pays directly to the medical provider
- ❑ The insurance company recovers medical payments from the at fault party
- ❑ Coverage is inexpensive: mine runs \$60.00 a year for \$100,000 of coverage
